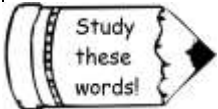

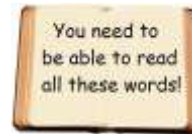

CRCT/OAS Practice – In April, our students will be required to take the Georgia Criterion Referenced Competency Test (CRCT). If you have access to a computer, I would strongly encourage you to allow your child to utilize the “Online Assessment System” (OAS). Go to the school’s webpage <http://www.cowetaschools.org/arbor/> and you will see OAS icon. Click on the icon and it will take you to a new page and then prompt you for a logon ID and password ID. The logon and password ID can be found on a sticker on the front page of your child’s agenda.

At the next screen select “View Student Tests” or “View Teacher-Assigned Tests”. Once your child completes a test, please go over the incorrect answers with him/her (please remember some of the subject matter may not have been covered in class thus far). I will also be checking results periodically. Please let me know if you have any questions. ***Popup Blocker might need to be disabled! Please note – not all skills have been taught thus far.
